After an introduction to XSLT, it focuses on applying transformations in some real-world scenarios, such as developing a discussion forum, transforming documents from one form to another, and generating content for wireless devices. The book discusses several common XSLT processors and the TRAX API, paying special attention to performance issues. Although there is a brief tutorial introduction to the XSLT language, the primary focus of the book is not on learning XSLT or developing stylesheets; it is on making practical use of transformations in Java code.
